ORDINANCE NO. 04-2020

An Ordinance to regulate the USE of FIREARMS within the Village of Casnovia, Michigan.

The Village ordains:

Section I:


It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot any gun, pistol, revolver or firearm of any kind within the Village of Casnovia in a careless or reckless manner, or in such a manner as to damage or endanger any other person or property.

Section II:

Anyone found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), together with costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in any jail or workhouse in the County for a term not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.
