ORDINANCE NO. Δ 2024-05 Amended -2020-04 Δ

AN ORDINANCE Δ 2024-05, to amend the established 2020-04 ordinance “Use of Firearms” furthermore referred to as “Discharge of Weaponry Within the Village of Casnovia” To protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Village of Casnovia by regulating the use of Weaponry within the Village of Casnovia and to provide penalties for violation and any of the provisions of this ordinance. Δ (Note: The presence of the Delta symbol Δ before and after a section will denote a change to the ordinance.)

THE VILLAGE OF CASNOVIA ORDAINS:

Δ Section 1. Purpose:

To amend and regulate the Ordinance for the Village of Casnovia formerly known as “Use of Firearms” renamed “Regulate the Discharge of Weaponry Within the Village of Casnovia” To protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Village of Casnovia by regulating the use of weaponry and to provide penalties for violation and any of the provisions of this ordinance.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge weaponry of any kind within the Village of Casnovia.

Section 2. Definitions:

For the purpose of the ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

Firearm: except as otherwise specifically defined, includes any weapon which will, is designed to, or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by action of propulsion.

Bow and Arrow and Crossbow: not defined as firearm as it uses mechanical action to propel projectiles.

Section 3. Exceptions to Prohibition on discharge of Firearms and Other Weaponry.

Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not apply to the discharge of a firearm or other weaponry in the following conditions:

- In the protection of life:
- A discharge by law enforcement officers in the performance of their duties:
- An established and lawfully permitted educational program properly supervised:

- Military functions, such as parades, funerals, firing blank charges, where all necessary permits have been acquired.
- Section 1 shall not prohibit the discharge of firearms or other weaponry where state law has pre-empted this authority and specifically authorized, in a hunting control area, the discharge of weapons pursuant to Act 159 of Public Acts of 1967 as amended.

Section 4. Penalties

- A violation of this Ordinance is declared to be a nuisance per se. Any violation is a municipal civil infraction, for which the fine shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 for the first offense and not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 for subsequent offenses, in the discretion of the Court, and in addition to all other costs, damages, and expenses provided by law.
- For the purposes of this section, “subsequent offense” means a violation of this Ordinance committed with respect to a separate incident by the same person within 12 months of a previous violation of the ordinance for which said person admitted responsibility or was adjudicated to be responsible. Each day that such a violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 8. Repealed/Amended Ordinances:

Ordinance No 2020-04 is hereby repealed/amended and replaced with Ordinance No. 2024-05

Section 9. Severability:

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or sub-section is declared to be void or ineffective for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion hereof.


Section 10. Publication/Effective Date:


