### **Waste and Recycling:**

- Please do not leave trash and recycling bins at the roadside.
- Please pull the trash and recycling bins back from the road after pickup by Granger
- Garbage bags sitting outside of garbage cart will not be picked up.

Contact the Village Office if you need an extra cart.

Do not place anything other than recycling in the recycle bin.

Anything other than recycling will cause the recycle truck to be turned away and the whole load will be dumped at the landfill.

Please keep sidewalks clear of obstructions, including garbage and recycling bins.

Please abide by the Village ordinance, always keep your pets on a leash when not on your property. Please contact Kent County Animal Control at (616)632-7300 option 1 for concerns regarding loose dogs. If you are threatened by a loose dog, please call **911**.

### **Sewer Notifications**

**Sewer Bills:** Quarter four bills are due December 31, 2025. Please pay by check or exact change. We cannot accept debit or credit cards.

**Do not Flush** paper towels, Handi Wipes, or baby wipes (flushable or not) down toilets. These cause blockages in the sewer system.

**Do not Dump** chemicals in the village sewer to avoid costly repairs.

**Parking of any vehicle is always prohibited on the Village right of way between the sidewalk and street or on Village Sidewalks.**

### **Speed Limit and Safety**

Please follow the posted speed limit of 30 MPH in the village. **Approach DPW work areas with caution to keep our staff safe!**

**Village Elections:** The Village President and two Council Member seats are up for election November 2026. The Village President is a two-year term, and the Council Member seats are four-year terms.
