## Trash and Recycling:

Residents are reminded to promptly remove trash and recycling bins from the roadside following collection. Please ensure that garbage bags are placed inside the carts, bags left outside will not be collected. Place only recyclable materials in the recycling bin; improper items can result in the entire load being redirected to the landfill. Waste bins must not block sidewalks to maintain pedestrian safety.

**Use caution near DPW work areas.**

**Observe the 30 mph village speed limit and use caution near DPW work areas.**

**Village Elections:** Three positions will be decided at the Nov 2026 elections. Village President, a two-year term, and two – four-year Council Member positions. ## Unleashed Pets:

The Village ordinance require pets to be leashed off your property. For loose dogs, call Kent County Animal Control at (616)632-7300, option 1. If a loose dog threatens you, call 911.

**Wastewater System:** Paper towels, Handi Wipes, sanitary wipes, and chemicals must not be flushed down toilets, or placed in the wastewater system as these items can damage the system and create expensive repairs.
